**ARRIVAL TIME &** SIGNING IN:

Parents/Carers will need to sign in their child/ren at the Hall via a QR code. Students are

to arrive between 8.45 and 9.15am.

**DEPARTURE TIME** & SIGNING OUT:

Parents/Carers will need to sign out the child/ren at the Hall via a QR code. Students will

depart between 2.15 and 2.30pm.

TRANSPORT:

Transport to and from the workshop is a parental responsibility. If your school is planning

Instrument, music stand, tutor book, 2B pencil, eraser, spare reeds/oil as required. Talk to your instrumental teacher if you have difficulty providing any of the above items as

they may be able to help you find a solution.

FOOD:

Students will need to bring their own morning tea, lunch and a bottle of water each day. Tuckshop facilities are not available and students are not permitted to leave the venue

to purchase food.

ATTIRE:

Students need to wear their school uniform and appropriate footwear. Remember to

bring a hat to wear at break times. A no hat, no play policy will be in place.


