## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving the National Minimum Standards in NAPLAN to 95% in Year Three, 90% in Years Five, Seven and Nine, with a particular focus on Writing (Explicit Improvement Agenda)
- Improve the percentage of students achieving a Level of Achievement of B or above to 50% and students achieving a C or above to 80% in all subject areas
- Sustain the percentage of graduates achieving a QCE or QCIA at 100%
- Sustain attendance levels of students above 92%

  - QCE / QCIA certification rates
  - Headline Indicators

- Increase access to expertise:
  - School Based Apprenticeships and School-Business relationship development
  - Speech Language
  - Pedagogical Coaching
  - Implementation of Social and Emotional wellbeing programs
